He was also a member of the ABA TECHSHOW Executive Board for five years, held every Spring in Chicago. He founded and co-chaired the ABA GP|Solo Division's Annual National Solo & Small Firm Conference in 2006 and 2007, and founded and chaired the first Wisconsin Solo & Small Firm Conference in 2007. He has also provided advice to a number of State Bar associations in the U.S. regarding starting their own solo and small firm CLE conferences.
